- Your manuscript must have between 6000 and 8000 words
- All papers should be sent electronically to miland@uj.ac.za
- Apply the Harvard method of referencing
- Use 2.54 cm or 1" margins
- Use only 11 pt Times New Roman font
- Paper size must be set to A4
- Spelling must be set to English UK
- Line spacing should be 1½
- Justification should be set to full
- All pages should be numbered

- An abstract
- The full names and surname of all the authors
- Your affiliated institute
- Key words
- Email address
